THE ONGOING PARADE OF NEW EVANGELICALISM

..New Evangelicalism Is Inclusivistic..The Christian Bookstore Association held their 30th annual gathering in July at St. Louis with 350 booths and dealing with 8000 bookstore operators. Eternity magazine for Sept. 1979 said:"Nothing in Christendom better illustrates the wide spectrum of evangelicalism. Under one roof and in brotherhood with the independent fundamentalists, the truly Reformed groups, the new charismatics, the old Pentecostals, as well as the social activists, the holiness crowd, and the Roman Catholics living together in harmony for five glorious days. When formal ecumenical efforts fail, merchandising succeeds." What a confession.

..BBF Pastor Greg Dixon Joins Criswell and other leaders of the Southern Baptist Convention in the 1980 James Robison Bible Conference, Jan.23-26,1980 at Fort Worth Convention Center. Other speakers: Adrian Rogers, E.V. Hill, Peter Lord, Bailey Smith, Charles Stanley, Dudley Hall, and others. Most of these are SBC leaders, but all of them are ecumenical supporters of ecumenical evangelism as practiced by Dr. Billy Graham. Dr. Dixon is too good a man to be identified with such a crowd.

..Evangelical Ecumenism and Inclusivism... The 1980 convention of the National Religious Broadcasters will feature Dr. Jerry Falwell and Jim Bakker of the PTL charismatic Club on the same panel. Other speakers are: Leighton Ford, an evangelist on the evangelical leftwing; Thomas Zimmerman of the Assemblies of God; Oswald Hoffman, who has fronted for the liberals in the Lutheran Church--Missouri Synod; Pex Hubbard, charismatic TV evangelist; James Robison, Southern Baptist evangelist; plus Theodore Epp. Not one militant Fundamentalist in the crowd. This will be a field day for the New Evangelicalists. Dr. Falwell claims to be a separatist and then repudiates it regularly and systematically by his activities, associations and connections.

..Billy Graham and Archbishop Fulton Sheen The Religious News Services dispatch from New York (12-11-79)--"Evangelist Billy Graham said the late Archbishop Fulton JSheen 'broke down many walls of prejudice between Catholics and Protestants' during a long colorful career of writing and preaching in the pulpit and on radion and television..."I counted it a privilege to have known him as a friend for over 35 years," said Dr. Graham.(Cont. Column One,P.g 1)..

THE FALWELL PHEONOMENON OF COMPROMISE

..Living Bible Publishers are Honored in Jerry Falwell's Journal Champion for Nov. 23, 1979 with a picture of the Liberty Baptist Institute Dean, Dr. Harold Wilmington, receiving the 100,000th copy of his book, The King Is Coming, from Wendell Hawley, Vice President and Editor-in-Chief, of Tyndale House Publishers of Wheaton, Ill. Tyndale is Ken Taylor's publishing firm which puts out the Living Bible. The presentation was made at Thomas Road Baptist Church during the national TV program of Dr. Falwell. Tyndale is the publisher of the Bible Story Book authored by Pearl Buck, the notoriously liberal unbelieving former Presbyterian missionary in China, whom J. Gresham Machen cited as Exhibit A of apostasy in the Presbyterian Church USA mission program.

..Liberty Baptist College Trustees Meet.. The 18-member Cooperating Board of the Lynchburg School met during the Recent Super-Conference. Serving on this Board, according to the Journal Champion for Nov 23, 1979 are: Wendell Zimmerman, Dr. Herbert Fitzpatrick, Dr. Greg Dixon, Dr. John Rawlings, Dr. Ray Batema, plus Jerry Prevot, Dr. David Cavin.

..A Full Page Endorsements For New Bible produced by Thomas Nelson Publishers appeared in Christianity Today for Nov.2, 1979. It is the New King James Bible, with endorsements on this page from Dr. Jerry Falwell, Elder Hal Rutherford of the Seventh Day Adventist Church, Dr. Thomas Zimmerman of the Assemblies of God, Anglican Bishop A.W. Goodwin-Hudson, Dr. Luis Palau, Dr. W.A. Criswell, Dr. Lloyd Ogilvie, and three very prominent SBC leaders: Dr. Russell Dilday, Dr. Wm. G. Tanner, and Dr. Adrian Rogers, and others.

..One Of Jerry Falwell's Deans Resigns... On the TV newscast of December 19, 1979 in Virginia, a pastor wrote:"I heard on the news tonight that Dr. Falwell's Dean ...a man by the name of Hughes, resigned. He said he resigned for the following reasons:1) Because Dr. Falwell has lured a Hyper-Calvinist to teach in his school and 2), That Dr. Falwell's last fund-raising campaign was a fake financial crisis perpetrated only to drain more money from the American people to enlarge the 'program.'"

INTERCHURCH NEWS FOR CONSERVATIVES

..C.S. Lewis Deeply Involved In Occultism. David C. Cook put out a S.S. lesson series "Lifestyle" with a "Response book" with this heading: "Chronicles of the Christian Faith from C.S. Lewis- Voyage to Narnia." On page 17- "Lewis' last words before his death have not been recorded. But his last words after his death were heard and published by no less a figure than J.B. Phillips, the highly respected Bible translator. Phillips claims to have seen Lewis twice after Lewis' death; Lewis looked drossily radiant. (One thinks of the liberated statues.) And both times the cheerful Lewis gave Phillips an encouraging message. Like Lucy, J.B. Phillips is either lying or tellings us the truth." A foot note draws attention to J.B. Phillips book "Ring of Truth" (Macmillan, 1967).

..The United Methodist Church Congress on will be held on Jan. 1-4, 1980 on the campus of Oral Roberts University. It is an official congress of the apostate Methodist Church. A colorful promotional folder states: "Co-sponsored by the United Methodist Council on Evangelism and the Board of Discipleship" of the U.M.C. The Speakers are: Luis Palau, Oral Roberts, Charles Allen, Billy Graham, Sam Kamalseson, Alan Walker, and several others. This is a daring mixture of liberals, Charismatics and New Evangelicals. Dr. Billy Graham will guarantee the huge crowds in support of this wickedly modernistic religious machine. Good men like Palau, Graham and Kamalseson will be using their energies, lending their influence, and give solid support to building up something which ought to be torn down.

..The Social Gospel Can Be Real Costly.... The Methodist Pacific Homes of the Pacific and Southwest Methodist conferences have been in receivership for past two years. The Methodist church has had to pay \$1 million annually for legal defense. In 1977 a lawsuit was filed by 1,9000 elderly residents asking the Methodist Church to fulfill the life-care contracts or pay \$336 million. Richard E. Mathews, court-appointed trustee, said it would take \$140 to do this. Matthews has offered a plan to pay \$47 million. In a report of Oct. 26, 1979, filed with Fed. Bankruptcy Judge James E. Moriarty, Mr. Matthews accused Pacific Homes and Methodist Church officials of perpetrating a fraud on unsuspecting residents in the name of the church for more than 25 years." (RNS-12-10-79)...

..The Three Clergymen Who Went To Iran were a most unfortunate selection, and they will certainly do no good for America. One of them is the notoriously liberal leftwinger and radical social actionist - Wm. Sloane Coffin of New York's Riverside Church, which was built by Rockefeller millions under leadership of Harry Emerson Fosdick.

SCHULLER SAYS THE BOOK DOES NOT SAVE

..A Trusted Fundamentalist News Reporter - (Dr. Marion Reynolds) took down these words of Dr. Robert Schuller, as he addressed the most daring ecumenical convocation of 1979 at Stanford University, August 27-31, 1979, under sponsorship of Fuller Seminary and the S.F. Roman Catholic Archdiocese: "To this day there are people who say that Schuller doesn't preach the Word. I may not quote Scriptures, but I preach the Word because, to me, the Word is Christ. And when I say I preach the Word, I preach Christ and I make a distinction between the Scriptures and the Word. The Word- in the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God. And the Word has a name and the name is Jesus. Christ died on the cross for me- the Book didn't! I'm saved by the blood- not the Book, and Christ is my Lord, not the Scriptures."

..This Is Pure Unadulterated Neo-Orthodoxy One of the tragic actions of Neo-orthodoxy is to drive a wedge between Christ and His Word. Bishop Gerald Kennedy said, "Ours is not a religion based on a book, it is true for the center of Christianity is the personality of Jesus." (His Word Thru Preaching, pp.96,97). That's a lie. Methodist liberal Harris Franklin Rall said: "Strictly speaking, we do not define a Christian as one who accepts the Bible but as one who accepts Christ." That's wrong, too. Dr. J. Carter Swaim said in S.F. in Dec. 5, 1960 at the NCC: "God's best Word to man is not a book but a Person". That's false. Dr. Robt. G. Torbet wrote in Bethel Seminary quarterly (May 1961)- "Our ultimate authority is not a book or an institution, or a creed, but a living Person, the incarnate Son of God." That is error. Billy Graham wrote in Eternity magazine: "I do not believe that the ground of our fellowship is to be the inerrancy of Scripture, but, rather, the ground of our fellowship is to be the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ." That is tragic. We have no Christ but the Jesus of Scripture. In the Bible Jesus so identified Himself with the Scriptures that to dishonor the Bible was to dishonor Him. Read 8:38. Read John 12:48.

..No One Is Saved Apart From The Word.. We read in James 1:18- "Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a king of first fruits of his creatures." People are born again by two agents- (Continued back page, column two)

FULTON SHEEN ON ROBT. SCHULLER'S PROGRAM

The late Roman Catholic Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen appeared on the Hour of Power TV network program, of Dr. Robert Schuller, released on the West Coast on Sunday, Jan. 6, 1980. It was a repeat of the TV program at the Garden Grove Community Church of March 5, 1972, and presented as a Memorial Tribute by Dr. Schuller to the noted Roman Catholic priest. It was an impressive TV presentation as he addressed Dr. Schuller's congregation dressed in his colorful red and purple Roman robe. The truth is that Archbishop Sheen probably preached a message that was closer to the true Gospel than what Dr. Schuller preaches each Sunday on television. A copy of the address by Fulton Sheen maybe had by writing to: Robert Schuller, Garden Grove, California 92642. Dr. Schuller was the Chairman of the Billy Graham Crusade held several years ago in Orange County. Fulton Sheen died on December 9, 1979 at the age of 84 years. Dr. Billy Graham was quoted by RNS(12-11-79) of Sheen- "I counted it a privilege to have known him as a friend for over 35 years ...I mourn his death and look forward to our reunion in Heaven." That meant his friendship started in 1944, which was three years before Billy Graham succeeded Dr. W.B. Riley as President of Northwestern Schools in Minneapolis.

When this happens the local church will grow. I highly recommend the Robert Schuller Film workshop as a practical and helpful on-location training resource for accomplishing this in the local church."

..Billy Graham To Meet With The Pope. In a RNS dispatch from Urbana (12-31-79) Dr. Billy Graham made big news. "Asked by a reporter whether it was true that he was planning a meeting with Pope John Paul II sometime soon, Mr. Graham said he would 'rather not comment,' but added that the answer was a qualified yes- but I'm not prepared to talk about it now."

JAMES ROBISON'S TV FUNDAMENTALIST ATTACK

..It All Happened on His TV Network.. The Plains Baptist Challenger for December - 1979 stated: "Southern Baptist Evangelist James Robison, in his television broad - cast of December 16, 1979, delivered a scathing attack upon fundamentalists. According to Robison, the fundamentalists are the Pharisees of today. This is not a new line of attack, but one that moder - nists have used for a long time in their vilification of the separatist fundament - alists."

..The Pharisees Were The Fundamentalists. Robison is quoted: "And they were the fundamentalists, you might say, by that I mean the rank fundamentalists that worship the Bible. I love the word, fund - amentalist, but I don't think you ought to make a God out of your position, and hate everybody else, and get mad at me if I go over and pray with an Assembly of God pastor, go over and pray with a char - imatic, and just say, 'God, have your way in our lives.' You say, 'you ought not to do that'. I don't like your rotten atti - tude. You're just like a Pharisee, always condemning, always putting other people down. They didn't have the love of God in them. They didn't like Peter and John and they complained..."

..His Evangelical Inclusivism Comes Out.. Later in his broadcast, Robison is quoted "We don't need to fuss among ourselves . . . We need to love each other. If Christians don't put their hands together- man I tell you, I enjoyed so much praying with all men of all denominations. I prayed with Rex Humbard and Pat Robertson and Billy Graham and Bill Bright, and some of these other leaders. And we prayed, just prayed together and I want to tell you something, we don't agree on all points and issues, but God was with us, because the Lord wants us to love one another. I heard about Rex Humbard having some trouble financially, and I prayed, 'God help him.' I heard about Jerry Falwell having some trouble financially, I got on my face and said, 'God help Jerry.' I want to have a part in helping those men"

..Some Conclusions About James Robison... A man who has been supporting the apos - tasy of the Southern Baptist Convention through the Cooperative Program, both financially and morally, as Robison has done, is in no position to sit in judge - ment upon the separatists who have obey - ed God's (Cont. next column).....

ORAL ROBERTS' PERSONAL FINANCIAL WEALTH

Oral Roberts lives in a home in Tulsa worth considerably in excess of \$250,000, plus another home in Palm Springs which is valued at over \$1,000,000. He wears Brioni suits which cost from \$500 to \$1,000, and had a shipment of hand crafted boots which cost \$300 each. He drives in a \$33,000 Mercedes or a Cadillac Seville. The annual income for his association exceeds \$60, 000,000, but provides not accounting to the public. Both he and Richard belong to Thunderbird Country Club of Palm Springs, which has a price tag today of \$25,000 each. He flies around in a \$2 million fan jet falcon. His personal income in 1955 was over \$145,000. Personal royalty from his books in 1955 was \$80,000. He and Richard belong to Southern Hills Country Club which now is worth \$18,000 per mem - bership. He has 24 TV cameras in the security system of his home. If his son - in-law accumulated an estate of \$10 mil - lion when he died in a plane crash, Oral's must be considerably higher. Con - sidering all the power and wealth to which he has acces - "his 'salary' and his power exceed that of men who make \$500,000 per year." Ora's operation over one ten-year period took in an estimated \$300 million. He receives an average of over 20,000 letter per day, with an aver - age contribution of \$5 for each letter. He conducts 5 to 6 seminars each year consisting of select people, which bring in between \$2½ and \$3 million for each seminar. He tried to hire a basketball coach for \$2½ million in salary (payable in ten years). The City of Faith Hospital complex was to cost \$100 million, accord - ing to word God spoke to him directly. However, inflation and other costs will boost this close to \$400 million. 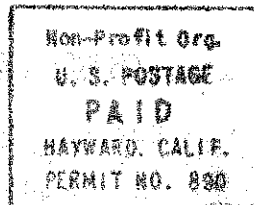

WHERE IS DR. GEORGE ARTHUR BUTTRICK NOW ?

One of the most prominent liberal preachers of this century died on January 23, 1980 at the age of 87 years- Dr. George A. Buttrick. He came to prominence in the 27 years (1927-54) while serving as pastor of Madison Avenue Presbyterian Church of New York City. He was president of the old Federal Council of Churches from 1939 to 1941. He held professorships at Harvard, Union Theological Seminary, and Garrett Seminary in Evanston. He lectured at Southern Baptist Seminary at Louisville. He wrote a book "The Christian Fact and Modern Doubt" (Scribners). Remember, as you read this appalling belief, that this one was invited to lecture at Louisville under the presidency of Dr. Duke McCall, soon to be elected President of the Baptist World Alliance.

..Literal Infallibility tends to insanity.

"Having dethroned an allegedly infallible Church, men dared not make venture with 'the B beyond that is within.' Craving external supports, they raised an infallible Book to the vacant throne. From that false move and its tyranny we now break free- but with what throes of spirit and strifes of tongues." (P.170). "Literal infallibility of Scripture is a fortress impossible to defend: there is treason in the camp. Probably few people who claim to 'believe every word of the Bible' really mean it. That avowal held to its last logic would risk a trip to the insane asylum." (P.162). "Meanwhile we should frankly admit the bankruptcy of 'literal infallibility,' and, under guidance of the facts, set out on a long hard quest for truth." (p.162). (John 17:17)..

..He Held strongly to evolutionary concepts..

"But to Israel was given a strange rigorous, redeeming sense of God. That consciousness was at the first primitive and vague. It grew, for evolution is the pattern of our life. Its early record was a mythology...The Old Testament is a collection of their religious writings. In Genesis are their myths and legends-" (pp. 175,176).

..He Walked out on some Gospel Preaching.

Dr. Buttrick writes: "Recently we heard a sermon from 'the word of God' on the text 'Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us.' Its primary thesis was that we are all cursed in Adam's sin...We had four children with us in the pew, one of whom had recently (Cont. nextcolumn).....

Then the seven-year-old at our elbow made his comment: 'Did God do that to me? My Bible doesn't say God is like that.' We determined we had no right to cloud a child's mind. We left the church. We fear no curse for the crime." (P.173)

Such a God, we suggested, had earned the verdict of the French sceptic: 'Your God is my Devil.' (pp. 173-174) ..

..He did not believe in Hell while on earth.. "A God who punishes men with fire and brimstone through all Eternity would hardly be Godlike. He would be almost satanic in cruelty and childlike in imagination - like a nasty little boy pulling off the wings of a fly. The Christian faith is that God here and hereafter is like Christ." (p. 283). (Better read Heb. 9:27; 10:31; John 3:36). Men who pass from this life, always gain a clearer theology on the other side.

..He Rejected the Physical Resurrection.. "The future is hidden. We must be faithful to our ignorance. Our deep instinct, our conscience, our love, our sense of God, all point to a future life. Jesus apparently conquered death: no man need covet an assignment to prove that he is dead. His disciples turned our world upside down in conviction of His deathlessness; and we ourselves strangely and compellingly, sense His presence. These are the grounds of hope. But we do not know - except by an invincible surmise. Why pretend we do?" (P. 284).

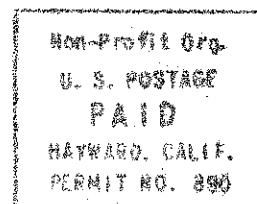

..Campus Crusade Working with Catholics...
In "The Wittenburg Door" magazine for June July, 1978, we found these words:" In Ireland, Campus Crusade is registered as a religious order. Poverty, chastity and obedience. ..Bill Bright Is For Women Ordination
"Most Campus Crusade staff people are very naive about the social dimension of the Gospel. It's something they never even thought of. But if Campus Crusade just did a little work in revamping their discipleship series that everybody goes through, just acquainting people very early in the process with the ethical teachings of Jesus, The Sermon on the Mount, the prophets, there would be some dramatic changes. If they could get the policy down that would correct the extreme subordination of women to men in the ministry. Which according to Vonette (and I have it on tape) is not what they want. Both affirm the ordination of women. Bill says that as far as he is concerned a woman could succeed him."

..Bright is Death on Premillennialism....
"Also in terms of Bill and Vonette's vision, there is a very strong radical element in it. Basically, Bill is opposed to millennialists. It's the truth. I've never asked him and I'm sure that he would never say that he is, but he is. What do I mean by that? Unlike people who think that you have to win the world in this generation before the Rapture (you know Hal Lindsay had to leave Campus Crusade because Bill didn't want dispensational theology taught in the organization -it's too negative) he feels that once the world is saved there will be an important second step (which links him up with Charles Finney, much more than Billy Graham) in the sanctification sense. Believers will automatically reconstruct society. They are going to end war, racism and everything else. That's why they are in the process of strengthening their black ministry. Did you know that Bill was (Cont. column two, pg.1).....

ASTOUNDING LETTER FROM E. STANLEY JONES ABOUT BILLY GRAHAM ECUMENICAL CRUSADES

One of the most far-reaching letters ever written to the Christian Century was by the late Dr. E. Stanley Jones, liberal Methodist spiritual leader, printed in the issue of Aug. 14, 1957. "Sir: If there be truth to Hegel's dictum, and I believe there is...then it seems to be applicable to the controversy regarding the Graham Crusade going on in your pages. Hegel said that thesis produces its opposite antithesis and then out of a struggle of opposites a third something is born in which the truth in thesis and the truth in antithesis are gathered up into something larger than each, a synthesis. The thesis in this controversy in the larger aspects in conservatism and it has produced its opposite liberalism...Out of this struggle of thesis and antithesis is emerging a something which seems to be gathering up the truth in each in a higher synthesis. The Graham Crusade is a symbol of that emerging synthesis. Both groups want to share Christ in differing terminology and in differing methods, but both want to share Christ. Their synthesis is emerging at a very important place - at the place of evangelism. After talking with Billy Graham, I am persuaded that he is more or less consciously one of the meeting places of this movement toward synthesis." When we view this letter in the light of the present existential mood which finds truth in all religions and positions, then we can begin to understand why the liberals and neo-orthodox are so willing to go along with Graham's ecumenical inclusive evangelism, where belief and unbelief are given equal honor and Christian recognition without penalty or discrimination.

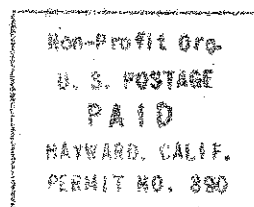

THE NEW EVANGELICAL WORLD OF MUSIC

..Disco Queen Summer Is Now "Born Again".
A UPI dispatch from Hollywood found in the Ashtabula (Ohio) Star Beacon for Feb. 2, 1980 stated: "America's No. 1 female singer-disco sexpot Donna Summer- has joined Bob Dylan, Stevie Wonder and Arlo Guthrie in making God the most important part of her life. The decision to become a born again Christian seems an obvious one to Miss Summer, who is best known to her fans for her ability to breathe hard and heavy to a suffocating disco pulse.."

..A Filthy And Adulterous Way Of Life...
The dispatch continues: "But will her regained Christian commitment conflict with her writhing, sensual performances? 'It probably won't have any impact on my performance, other than to maybe make it better,' she says. 'God doesn't call upon everyone to do the same thing. He's called me as I am. He expects someone, in whatever line of work they are in, to set an example of what His word is. He doesn't call upon everyone to preach His word either. He just calls upon everyone to be growing examples of what He is capable of doing. I think I'm a good example of what he is capable of doing.' Romans 6:1- 'What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?' Romans 6:2 - 'God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?' Such an adulterous way of life, which can boast of a relationship with the holy Son of God, is the direct result of the failure of Dr. Billy Graham and other New Evangelicals to preach the truth of Biblical Separation. We have lost the sense of the holiness of God in American Christianity.

..Doug Oldham's Charismatic Concert is set for a concert this month at Dr. Bebe Patten's Christian Cathedral, a noted charismatic center, presented for "Patten College Scholarship Fund." He is listed as the host of his own TV show "Hi Doug!" on Pat Robertson's charismatic network. REAGAN IS STRAIGHT ON THE SOCIAL GOSPEL

In the Tyndale House paper "Christian Times" for May 5, 1968, Gov. Ronald Reagan took a flat position in opposition to the Social Gospel. In response to the question How important are committed Christians today? And the church? Reagan answered: "Well I don't think they've ever been as important as they are today. And I do not mean by that, the so-called social gospel of the church thinking that it must militantly back programs of social reform, and so forth, and turning to government. In some instances, I think what the church is doing is asking government to take over the church's tasks. Now there's nothing in our religion that tells us that we can order salvation, or that we can force people to be good through coercion. Ours is a religion based on the absolute imperative of individual salvation of each individual having to find it in his own heart. And I think as we, with the great support of a large proportion of the church, as we turn toward the belief that we can find the answer to all our problems of brotherhood through law and coercion (the coercion of law or compulsion is perhaps a better word), as we do that, in a sense we're easing people's consciences about their own individual responsibility in which they say, 'Well, I've turned it over to the government. I pay my taxes. The government does the good works. And fine, I'm off the hook.' We can't go on doing that. I think that the place for the Christian is the acceptance of personal responsibility, and this even means in serving in government. Serving in civic affairs. And in finding all those things without waiting for government to find them. Finding these things that need to be done in the community, and finding how the people themselves can organize to do them voluntarily without waiting for government. I suggest to you that there is no right or left, only an up or down. Up to the maximum of individual freedom consistent with law and order, or down to the ant heap of totalitarianism."

PITIFUL APOSTASY OF A LIBERAL PREACHER

..Rev. Paul Blanshard is dead at 87 years. He was noted for violent opposition to the Roman Catholic Church and was a powerful voice for Americans and Others United for Separation of Church and State, a liberal group who have now proved themselves unworthy of support. The leaders of this group praised this atheist. Editor Herman Otten of the Christian News stated: "Any group which considers an adulterous atheist a saint and incorruptible and honest is not worthy of support...He expresses no repentance for his utterly immoral life style." (2-11-80).

..Blanshard Confesses He Was An Apostate.. In his 1973 autobiography, "Personal and Controversial" (Beacon, Boston)- he said, "In my zigzag career I have been transformed from Christian fundamentalist to humanist atheist, from stodgy Puritan to sexual rebel, from doctrinaire socialist to socialistic pragmatist." (P.40) (Read I Tim. 4:1-6; II Tim. 3:1-5; II Peter 3:3)

..His Ordination -A Classic In Deception.. His Congregational brethren were summoned to council by Dr. Henry Atkinson in southern Florida: "There is no doubt that I was unfit, but when I was examined in an open hearing the ministers failed to ask those questions that would have exposed my unfitness. No one asked me if I believed in the Virgin birth- I did not- or in the bodily resurrection of Jesus- I did not- or in the complete uniqueness of Jesus - I did not. Instead, the ministers happened to ask me several questions on theology and church history which, by pure chance, I was prepared to answer quite correctly and with adequate display of ecclesiastical learning. As I knelt at the end of the proceedings to become, by the laying on of hands, the Reverend Paul Blanshard, I had such an inner sense of tension and conflict that I almost stood up and said: Look here, gentleman, I agree with your moral aspirations and I love the concept of the church as a center for moral discussion, but I am much more a heretic than you think and I really don't belong to your bunch at all." (p.40-41).

..Christianity Is A Spurious Religion "It seems to me that the most spurious of all the great religions is Christianity. Its biblical miracles are childish, pre-scientific myths. Its theology has been taken right out of the caldrons of blood sacrifice and appeasement...Hitler murdered six millions Jews. The Christian God, in continuing genocide, (Cont.bk.pg.c.2)..

NEWS ABOUT THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

..Roman Catholic-Pentecostalist Dialogue.. at the Vatican heard a paper presented by Dr. Howard Ervin of Oral Roberts University. Dr. David du Plessis wrote a report on the conference in Logos Journal for Jan Feb. 1980, quoting the word of Pope Paul II while they were in audience with him: "My dear participants in the Roman Catholic / Pentecostal dialogue: Welcome again to Rome. For seven years this effort of mutual understanding and reconciliation has been going on and I wish to assure you that it has my fullest interest and prayerful support."

..Confusion About Catholic Evangelism Christianity Today for Jan. 4, 1980 reported on the noted Roman Catholic Archbishop who recently died: "Sheen's preaching crossed religious barriers; evangelical Protestants could have embraced his message as their own. Sheen personally introduced to Christianity such notables as former ambassador and congresswoman Claire Booth Luce, Communist Daily Newspaper editor Louis Budenz, and auto tycoon Henry Ford II. In a Christianity Today interview two years ago, Sheen stated his own preaching mission: 'I have taken a resolution all the rest of my life to preach nothing but Christ and him crucified.'" Christianity Today, a New Evangelical paper, should realize that Sheen simply introduced these people to the Catholic religion, and not to Christianity. By no stretch of the imagination could a Bible-believing Christian embrace the Catholic message or theology of Fulton J. Sheen.

..A Roman Catholic Book Review on Oral ... Every pastor should secure Jerry Sholes' book "Give Me That Prime Time Religion" a critical evaluation of Oral Roberts' video church. The National Catholic Reporter for Feb. 8, 1980 devotes a whole page on p.15- "Oral Roberts and his ilk represent, through their mass-media appeal to God-fearing people sitting in their TV rooms, the final technological estrangement of this individual from his society, his community, his neighborhood church. To Sholes, a minister's son, this is the greatest harm of Roberts' monumental self-aggrandizement. It is logical result, and an inevitable harm. NEW EVANGELICAL NEWS DEVELOPMENTS

..Patricia Gundry's Feminist Book was endorsed by Western Baptist Seminary (CBA) President, Dr. Earl D. Radmacher. He stated on the book's jacket in a promotional page: "Very significant contribution ... I have recommended it over and over again to individuals and groups." This is the highly controversial book by a vigorous promoter of the ERA amendment, whose feminist views finally brought about the firing of her husband, Dr. Stanley Gundry from the theology faculty of Moody Bible Institute of Chicago.

..An Eastern Fundamentalist Leader writes "As you know, we have a large number of Navy personnel here. A constant stream of enlisted men and officers come through out church. The other week I was answering questions from some of them about out Bibl Institute when one of the men asked about C.S. Lewis. I briefly gave him a run-down on Lewis and asked him what promoted his question. He said that C.S. Lewis is recommended among Christian groups within the Navy. Lewis' books are passed around or sold or given away by the Navigators. I was surprised to learn how many of our regular Navy men owned copies."

..This Is Called Evangelical Inclusivism. Bethel College and Seminary Founders Week for 1980 was Jan.28-31. The list included Beverly LaHaye teamed up with Dr. Roger Frederickson of Wichita, former President of the American Baptist Convention, whose church is in the National Council of Churches; Cliff Barrows of the Billy Graham team; Dr. S.M. Lockridge, eloquent black preacher from San Diego; Dr. Harm Webber, President of Judson College (ABC) Maj. Gen. Kermit Johnson, Army Chief of Chaplains, and others: Berkey Mickelsen, Charles Smith, Lee Eliason, Jim Smoke, Edward Buchanan, Ted Johnson, and Paul Redin. An interesting aspect is Dr. John Walvoord of Dallas Seminary, a noted dispensational scholar appearing on the same platform with Dr. Clarence Bass, one of the leading opponents of dispensationalism today.

NEWS ALONG THE SOUTHERN BAPTIST FRONT

..Southern Baptist Evangelist Jim Robison was scheduled in a BBF church, Bethel Baptist Church, where Dr. E.J. Brinson is pastor. The Church Bulletin "Life" for Oct.21, 1979 advertised James Robison to speak on Oct.21. The bulletin stated: "Dr. W.A. Criswell, pastor of the First Baptist Church Dallas, Texas: 'He is the Charles Finney and D.L. Moody of our day.' Dr. Jerry Falwell, pastor of the Thomas Road Baptist Church, Lynchburg, Virginia, and 'Old Time Gospel Hour' speaker: 'James Robison is the prophet of God for our day.'"

..Louisville Baptist Seminary Student unbelief..Dr. Harold Lindsell in his book "The Bible in the Balance" tells of a Master's thesis by a Louisville Southern Baptist Seminary student on theological belief in the student body. "Only 55% of the student body believed in the virgin conception and birth of Christ. Only 38% held that it was absolutely necessary to hold the Bible was God's truth. Only 58% believed that the Devil actually existed was absolutely necessary. Noel Wesley Hollyfield concluded that 'a trend toward doctrinal liberalism was discovered in the ThM- PhD students.' It seems that as students progressed up the educational ladder at Southern, the more liberal they became." (Quoted in Christian News, 1-14-80, p.9). Southern Seminary is to the SBC what Notre Dame is to the Catholics - their premier institution. Remember, this is the Seminary where Dr. Duke McCall has been President for decades. He is the newly proposed president of the Baptist World Alliance. He must be held accountable for this volume of unbelief.

..Unusually Heavy Losses Of SBC Ministers Dr. Carl F.H. Henry, writing in the January 4 Christianity Today, stated: "This largest predominantly conservative denomination in the United States, with 13 million members, not only faces a decline in the number of baptisms, but is now also losing 1,000 pastors from the ministry annually. ..More Falwell Trips With the Charismatics

The Conservative Digest for November 1979 reveals some more compromising affiliations of the Lynchburg pastor: "A major new conservative Christian organization, the Religious Round table, was launched this past September 28 in Washington, D.C. Founded by Eddie McAteer, a successful businessman and a life-long lay leader in Christian activities...McAteer, a sales marketing executive with Colgate-Palmolive most of his adult life, has been extremely active as a lay spiritual leader. He was a delegate to Billy Graham's 1974 Congress on World Evangelism in Switzerland, and is actively involved in helping dynamic young evangelists, Richard Hogue and Del Fehsenfeld. He will be escorting a group of spiritual leaders, including Jerry Falwell, Pat Robertson and Adrain Rogers, to Taiwan in the near future. He serves on boards of several Christian ministries, including Kim Wickes Ministries, Wycliffe Bible Associates, Bill Glass Evangelism and the All India Prayer Fellowship."

..Dr. Paul B. Smith Wrote A Decade Ago ...

The Pastor of the largest New Evangelical Church in Canada, The People's Church, is Dr. Paul B. Smith. "The Sword of the Lord" paper of Sept. 11, 1970 had an extensive book review of "Builder of Bridges" (Life of Dr. Bob Jones, Sr.) by Paul Smith. After he commented on Dr. Bob's struggle with Graham's evangelism, he said: "With the coming and passing of the Minneapolis Congress on Evangelism, with an unbelievable emphasis on the social gospel and the Canadian Congress on Evangelism with an unbelievable number of liberal delegates (105) of a total of 800 delegates will be from the modernistic United Church of Canada), some of us may have to stop and take a second look at the scriptural validity of ecumenical evangelism." NEW EVANGELICAL DEFECTIONS FROM FAITH

..Peale's Unbiblical Pluralistic Religion. Dr. Norman Vincent Peale's magazine, "Guideposts" for March 1980 sets forth his common denominator religion on page 22- "From the beginning Guideposts has endeavored to promote amity and understanding among the different branches of the Judeo-Christian Tradition. We publish true stories that concern the three major faiths in this country: our staff is made up of Protestants, Catholics and Jews; and so is our readership. We put an emphasis upon the area of agreement among these faiths: Belief in one God, in prayer and immortality, adherence to the Ten Commandments, dependence of Bible teachings, and always the important of personal growth in the particular faith of one's choosing." Remember, this was the Church Dr. Peale's Marble Collegiate that received the most referral cards of any one church in Billy Graham's 1957 New York Crusade.

..Dale Evans Rogers Honors The Mormons...

"Some 2,500 guests including Roy Rogers and Dale Evans and Dr. Norman Vincent Peale will attend a dinner in Salt Lake City, March 28 honoring the 85th birthday of Spencer W. Kinball, president of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (Mormon). Other guests include the Rev. Morton A. Hill, president of Morality in Media, Inc." (Christian News 2-25-80 p.2). After this is filed in your folder marked: "New Evangelicals and the Cults", then you might write Mr. and Mrs. Roy Rogers, Apple Valley, California and ask for their justification of confusing the Gospel and the Christian Faith by giving legitimacy to an anti-Biblical cult.

..Oral Roberts Betrays The Christian Faith

SIGNIFICANT ACT-PRESBYTERIAN SEPARATION

The most astounding news story of all the day's dispatches of Religious News Service on March 12, 1980 was this from Philadelphia: "Members of Tenth Presbyterian Church here, as well known inner-city congregation, have voted to secede from the United Presbyterian Church because of its insistence that women be elected to the governing boards of all congregations." The pastor of the 750-member congregation, Rev. James Montgomery Boice, stated: "We're not vindictive... We're not calling the church apostate. We just think it's going one direction and we've gone another." The dispatch indicated that the UPC General Assembly, their national body, was expecting in May to legislate nationally prohibiting seceding congregations from taking their property with them, so the local church beat them to it. The parent denomination is getting mean and brutal. The dispatch concluded: "The UPC's Philadelphia Presbytery scheduled a meeting at Tenth Presbyterian for March 14, at which time Dr. Boice and the church session would be asked to show cause why the pastor should not be defrocked and the church property placed in the hands of an administrative commission." All of this stirs many observations. This was the church made famous by the ministry of the late Dr. Donald Grey Barnhouse. Since then Dr. Boice has had a strong Bible preaching ministry, over 300 Radio stations. Apparently he felt he must begin to obey what the Bible has been teaching on Separation. Before his death, Dr. Barnhouse was quite bitter against the separatists. We congratulate Dr. Boice for doing so late what should have been done decades ago. The UPC went apostate in the 1930s. The issues in the battle then were noble: the Deity of Christ, the bodily Resurrection of our Lord, the inspiration of the Bible as the Word of God, and modernism rampant on the mission fields. It seems a little tame to come out on the issue of women ordination. If one can accept the apostate wickedness of the UPC for four decades, it should really not have been bothered by such a "peripheral" issue such as women in the ministry. But, it's better late than never, and so we congratulate Dr. Boice for having some kind of courage of disassociating himself and his church from such a manifestly ungodly theological and esslesiastical (Continued back pg., C.2)...

..The Organist Lawsuit Against S.F. Church The preliminary hearing took place March 18, 1980 in S.F. Superior Court in City Hall in Judge John Ertola's department. It pitted the city's Gay Rights ordinance against the First Amendment protections of the U.S. Constitution. The Judge had done his homework well. Arguments were heard by opposing attorneys, in which Attorney John Whitehead asked that the case be dismissed against the Church brought by the gay organist who was fired by the church. Atty. Whitehead said the US Constitution absolutely prohibits the government from interfering in the spiritual matters of the Church. He said: "The government did not build this church, it does not support the church, and it has not business interfering with the church." The courtroom was jammed, with dozens outside in the hall, where Dr. David Innes led the group in prayer. The gays were clearly outnumbered in Diane Feinstein's gay city. The Judge will hand down his ruling at a later time.

JERRY FALWELL'S ECUMENICAL AFFILIATIONS

..The Coalition For The First Amendment..
The Atlanta Journal and Constitution for Feb. 16, 1980, P.6-B, lists the leaders of this group, which includes Dr. Charles Stanley of Atlanta (SBC), Dr. Adrian Rogers of Memphis (Pres. of SBC), and U.S. Senator Jesse Helms: "Others on the coalition list of sponsors include the Rev. James Robison of Hurst, Texas, a Southern Baptist evangelist; Paige Patterson, president of the Criswell Center for Biblical Studies in Dallas; Jerry Falwell of the 'Old Time Gospel Hour,' Pat Robertson of the 700 Club; Jimmy Bakker of the PTL Club; Bill Bright of Campus Crusade for Christ; Ben Armstrong of the National Religious Broadcasters; and Robert Dugan of the National Association of Evangelicals."

..Falwell Applies for Accreditation.. Perhaps one of the most serious developments is the seeking of accreditation for Liberty Baptist Seminary from the ecumenical Association of Theological Schools, formerly known as AATS. This is the only seminary accreditation group recognized by the US government, and it is wholly and totally controlled by the liberals and ecumenical forces. It is unthinkable that a professing "fundamental" seminary would apply for this. There is not a single Fundamental seminary in America which is involved, though there are several New Evangelical seminaries. It is indefensible to deliberately place oneself under the control of this despicable group. Recent history has several incidents of AATS control in seminary crises, such as at Midwestern Seminary, Southern Baptist Seminary, Concordia Seminary and several others. NEWS FROM THE LOCAL CHURCH OF LUNCHBURG

..Jerry Falwell and Homosexual Rights ..
"Homosexuals have every right of other Americans," Falwell said. "But when they break civil and divine law (by homosexual acts), they violate their rights and they're asking for special privileges, which I don't think they should have." In particular, evangelicals oppose hiring known homosexual teachers. "If they commit their sin in private and don't talk about it, we don't object to their teaching," Falwell said. "We are not attempting to make people live by biblical life styles. We are simply saying what is illegal and immoral should not be put on public display to the injury of young people." (The News and Observer, Raleigh, N.C. Sunday, Oct. 28, 1979, P.20-1).

..Jerry Falwell Hungry for Political Power
U.S. News and World Report (4-7-80 p.40) reported in a big article-"Old-Time Religion On the Offensive"-concerning Jerry Falwell: "Now, some evangelists are trying to use their shows as a source of political power. Nationally syndicated preachers such as Pat Robertson, Jerry Falwell and James Robison have been urging viewers to vote a strongly conservative line on such issues as abortion, welfare, pornography, big government, Communism and defense."

..More About Falwell's Moral Majority ..
"Two fundamentalist political action groups, Falwell's Moral Majority and the Christian Voice, are trying to raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for conservative candidates. Jimmy Carter and Ronald Reagan are among a host of presidential and congressional contenders who have met with broadcast evangelists in hopes of winning their support." (U.S. News and World Report, 4-7-80, p.40).

..Falwell Joins In New Political Force ..
The Conservative Digest for Nov. 1979 states on p.12: "A major new conservative Christian organization, the Religious Roundtable, was launched this past September 28 in Washington, D.C. Founded by Eddie McAteer... McAteer, a sales-marketing executive with Colgate-Palmolive most of this adult life, has been extremely active as a lay spiritual leader. He was a delegate to Billy Graham's 1974 Congress on World Evangelism in Switzerland... He will be escorting a group of spiritual leaders including Jerry Falwell, Pat Robertson and Adrian Rogers, to Taiwan in the near future." Falwell's agent, Dr. Bob Billings, was pictured at the founding meeting.

RELIGIOUS NEWS OF DEEPENING APOSTASY

..Norman Vincent Peale and Cult Religion..
"In Salt Lake City, Utah, Mormon Church President Spencer W. Kimball celebrated his 85th birthday at a banquet that filled 14 ballrooms of a historic hotel. More than 2,000 persons, including religious, civic and business leaders, attended the celebration. Dr Norman Vincent Peale called Kimball 'one of the greatest religious leaders of all time,' and told the audience 'we are privileged tonight to sit at the feet of a great man of God.'" Remember, Peale's church got more convert cards from the 1957 New York Graham Crusade than any other church. (Oakland Tribune, 3-31-80, P.C1)

..Indefensible Case Of Lutheran Unbelief..
Writing in the ALC Lutheran Standard against Creationist textbooks, Dr. Richard Simon Hanson, professor of religion at Luther College, Decorah, Iowa: "The creationists show a limited and twisted view of the Bible... The Bible's accounts of creation do not always agree in details or in the order of events... We must recognize that the Bible's accounts of creation are not scientific explanations at all. They are liturgical poems that exalt God as Lord of creation. They do not belong in a high school science textbook any more than a page of a textbook belongs in the hymn-book of the church." (Christian Century, March 26, 1980, P.343)

..Malcolm Boyd- Gay Episcopalian Priest..
who was invited by Westmont College on Nov. 23, 1971 to minister to the students wrote an article in the Nat'l. Catholic Reporter for Mar. 28, 1980, p.16, attacking the recent movie "Cruising." "Cruising", despite a limp-wristed disclaimer, savagely brutalizes all gays. Looking at the film, one sees through a glass darkly. How long, oh Lord? When will a film be made that tells, for example, the story of two gays- in Indianapolis, or Des Moines, Detroit or Tulsa- who have lived together for 20 years in fidelity and a stable relationship, hold responsible jobs, are gay leaders in their parish, attend concerts and ball games, vote and pay taxes, and spend an evening a week doing volunteer work? ..Important Bill by Sen. Nick Petris The bill known as SB 1493 passed the Senate Judiciary Committee on Tuesday, March 25, 1980 by a vote of 8-0 and was sent on to the Finance Committee. It repeals the attorney general's power to inspect church records. Religious leaders of all stripes showed up to support the bill in Sacramento: Unitarians, Seventh Day Adventists, Reform Judaism and Evangelicals. If this bill passes in the legislature, it gets the state government out of Faith Center in Glendale, Armstrong's World-wide Church of God and potentially every Fundamental church. Pray for its passage.

..Butterfly Definition of the New Birth.. Waiting in the dentist's office my wife found this brief note in a magazine; concerning one of the entertainment set who claims to be born again: "New Christian Lynda (Wonder Woman) Carter is a bit of a poet, with a touch of the lepidopterist. 'I think the term born again gives the wrong idea,' she says. 'I like to think of myself more as a butterfly. I felt that I was in the cocoon stage ... like a caterpillar...then suddenly the cocoon opened and I fluttered out.'"

..Rex Humbard Meets The Pope at Vatican.. "As we talked together, I sensed more and more that our mission is the same: to build the body of Christ; to uplift our brethren in the Lord; to win the world for the kingdom: to share that shining message that Jesus gave us to share ... 'You are loved.' I wish you could have been there, standing by side, as I shared those moments with Pope John Paul II. For those were milestone moments in my own personal life, in my spiritual life ...and I believe that you would have been just as moved as I was in that once-in-a-lifetime experience...I want you to feel in your heart what I felt in my heart as I stood in the Vatican. I want you to sense the moving of the Lord in your life, as I sensed Him speaking to me that day. I want you to experience that same anointing in your spirit, that anointing of the Lord, that I am feeling right now, as I write you." This is incredible. These TV ministers of the electronic church are leading the masses of protestants right back to that ecclesiastical religious system which will comprise the Church of anti-Christ.

..They Hope For A Million In Washington.. The Washington for Jesus Rally on April 29, 1980 will have Dr. M.G. "Pat" Robertson and Dr. Bill Bright as the co-chairman of this charismatic event, launched almost completely by the tongues elements. The Christian News for March 24, 1980 stated on p.13: "The result is a broad-based sponsor list taking in a wide spectrum of the Christian community, from Robertson, Shakarian, Bishop Patterson, Rev. A LEFT-LEANING NEW EVANGELICAL LAYMAN

..John B. Anderson is Roundly Denounced..
by his own Evangelical Free Church denomination. He is their most famous layman, with membership in the First Evangelical Free Church of Rockford, Illinois. The Evangelical Beacon editorial of April 1, 1980 said that Anderson "has the perfect right to express his convictions regarding abortion and other moral, social, economic and political issues. However, as he becomes more and more vocal in his pro-abortion stance, the Evangelical Free Church of America comes more and more in danger of being labeled, by association, of holding views similar to his on some key moral issues. It has come time to make it very clear that Rep. Anderson does not represent the consensus of opinion in the Free Church in regard to his pro-choice views on abortion." They drew attention to official church resolutions passed in 1977 on upholding the rights of the unborn child, and in 1978 warning against the practice of homosexuality.

..Anderson Supports Homosexual Rights ...
The RNS dispatch from Minneapolis on 4-3-80: "Rep. Anderson, the editorial said apparently is in sympathy with the gay rights movements since he sent a telegram of support to a gay rights fund-raising banquet in Los Angeles on March 6." It is extremely sad that Anderson, who gave promise of being an evangelical in Congress, should stoop to such a moral low that he would allow his name and prestige to be used to give support to an immoral lifestyle that is under the condemnation of the judgement of God as expressed in the Word of God.

..Anderson Calls Pro-Life Adherents Bullies..
The Evangelical Free "Evangelical Beacon" editorial accused Anderson of "strong and intemperate language in referring to the pro-life movement." The RNS bulletin stated: "In a four-page fund-raising letter he wrote in behalf of the National Abortion Rights Action League, Rep. Anderson, 'labeled pro-lifers as 'right-wing extremists' and warned of a 'reactionary coalition of right-wing groups' which are out to defeat pro-abortion political candidates,' the editorial said. The editorial quoted Rep. Anderson as writing, 'Frankly, I've had enough of the anti-choice zealots and their ability to put feet into Congress, state legislatures and (Continued back page., col. two).

NEW EVANGELICAL NEWS OF INTEREST

..Jerry Falwell and the Charismatic Rally
Concerning the big "Washington for Jesus" Rally bringing a million people to Washington on April 29, 1980, which was originated and sponsored completely by charismatics, we have this in the San Jose Mercury News, Apr. 5, 1980-"The supporters behind the movement include some of the most celebrated names at the conservative end of the religious spectrum, including Pat Robertson, president of the Christian Broadcasting Network; Bill Bright, president and founder of Campus Crusade for Christ; and the Rev. Jerry Falwell, pastor of the 16,000 member Thomas Road Baptist Church of Lynchburg, Va." The article indicated that strong support was also being given by Dr. Robt. Schuller of Garden Grove, Dr. David DuPlessis, Demos Sharkarian and some liberals.

..Evangelist Luis Palau's Brother-in-law..
Christianity Today for April 4, 1980 had an interesting paragraph showing the tie between Palau and one of the leading Latin American charismatics, Juan Carlos Ortiz: "Ortiz, the brother-in-law of well-known evangelist Luis Palau, is generally credited with popularizing the teachings of discipleship and shepherding, partly through his book 'Call To Discipleship'. He arrived in the United States from Argentina in 1977, and now lives in Cupertino, California. In an interview, Ortiz said the purpose behind his many speaking appearances is 'to disturb the ministers, if possible, even to confuse them so they have to rethink everything all over again ...I speak on the mobilization of every single believer in the church to discipleship.'" This shepherding idea has split the charismatic movement down the center.

..Evangelicals Confusing Truth and Error.
The Daily Review of Hayward, California for March 30, 1980 had this item on page 2: "The Mormon Church President Spencer W. Kimball celebrated his 85th birthday at a banquet that filled 14 ballrooms of a historic hotel in Salt Lake City ...Dr. Norman Vincent Peale called Kimball 'one of the greatest religious leaders of all time,' and told the audience 'we are privileged tonight to sit at the feet of a great man of God.' The birthday celebration fell during the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saint's 150th anniversary celebration...The banquet Friday night (Continued back pg., column two)..

GRAHAM CRUSADE PLANNED FOR MORMON AREA

..Billy Graham Coming To Salt Lake City.
Dr. Billy Graham is finally laying plans for a crusade in Salt Lake City, Utah, the home of the Mormon Church, which is now celebrating its 150th year of existence. A fundamentalist leader wrote: "It may be of interest to you to know that they have reversed their referral policy and will not be sending converts back to Mormon wards." All of this will be followed closely, in view of Dr. Graham's glowing praise of the Mormon Choir in the Reader's Digest a few years ago. We wonder whether Dr. Graham has the stamina to face the unpopular reaction of this Mormon-dominated city when they realize his crusade will not be sending converts to the Mormon churches.

..Graham's Statement Five Years Ago
was widely understood in praise of the Mormon gospel and Choir, found on page 2525 of the Reader's Digest for Nov. '75. The entire page was an advertisement of the Mormon Tabernacle Choir, promoting a recording. Dr. Graham is quoted: "Today, as never before, we need to hear the message spoken by our great gospel and patriotic songs. I congratulate Reader's Digest on its selection of the Mormon Tabernacle Choir." Reasonable men would from this statement that Dr. Graham wants to convey that his gospel and that of the Mormon church has much in common.

..A Big Theological Fuss Was Kicked Up
as a result of this endorsement by the ecumenical evangelist. The regional convention of the CBA, which had seven churches in Utah, was held in Salt Lake City in October 1975. The Conservative Baptist for Winter 1976 stated on p.19: "The southwestern messengers passed a resolution regarding Billy Graham's seeming endorsement of the Mormon Tabernacle Choir in the November 1975 Reader's Digest. The resolution expressed concern that people in our churches not be confused in thinking Graham believed the Mormon Tabernacle Choir adhered to the same Gospel as evangelicals. CBs were urged to write the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association of their concern over Graham's Statement."

..Graham Is A Clear And Present Danger
to missionaries and missions of the true Gospel as they labor in Mormon country, according to statements coming out of Utah. In one crusade, they fear that he can (Cont. bk.pg., col.two).....

THE SOUTHERN BAPTIST SEMINARY PRESIDENT SHOWS HIS MODERNIST ANGER ON INERRANCY

..The Battle On The Bible Is Intensifying
Dr. Duke K. McCall, who is destined to be the next president of the Baptist World Alliance, and therefore an influential world religious leader, almost 'lost his cool'. The following RNS (5-6-80) dispatch from Louisville states: "The president of a major Southern Baptist Seminary has warned that if a campaign by biblical inerrancy advocates succeeds, it would be comparable to a 'communist takeover' of the Southern Baptist Convention. Duke McCall, president of the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary here, was responding to a report that a group has mounted an effort to impress its views of Scripture upon the administrators of the SBC seminaries and universities... 'If I did not believe in God, I would predict and bet on the dissolution of the Southern Baptist Convention in the 1980s,' Dr. McCall told participants at the annual meeting of the SBC Historical Commission and Society here."

..The Apostate SBC Leaders Are Scared
stiff of what might take place, if those who hold to an inerrant Bible win the day." Baptist Press, the denomination's news agency, said recently that the inerrancy advocates aim to dominate the election of SBC presidents over the next decade. Since the convention president appoints the members of numerous committees, this would indirectly bring about the appointment of biblical inerrantists as trustees of SBC institutions, says the RNS dispatch."

..The Modernists Are Being Flushed Out
into the open and they can be mean-real mean. Too long the apostate leaders, such as Duke McCall, have enjoyed an immunity from criticism in the Southern Baptist Convention. 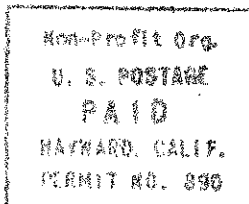

GRAHAM IS COMING TO SALT LAKE CITY

..With The Coming Graham Crusade In Utah, the spectre of Norman Vincent Peale comes back to mind. The Oakland Tribune of March 31, 1980 told about Dr. Peale as main speaker at the huge celebration in Salt Lake City of the birthday of the 85 year old Mormon President, Spencer W. Kimball. The music was brought by Roy Rogers and Dale Evans. Dr. Peale called Kimball "one of the greatest religious leaders of all time", indicates to us that Dr. Peale thinks the Mormon President ranks right up there with Abraham, Moses, David and Paul. He said, "We are privileged tonight to sit at the feet of a great man of God."

..What's The Connection Between Graham & Dr. Peale? Billy Graham was the luncheon speaker on Dec. 7, 1966 at the 7th General Assembly of the National Council of Churches in Miami. Mrs. Norman Vincent Peale presided: "I give unto you the world's evangelist, Billy Graham", she said in introduction. Dr. Graham responded: "I don't know of anyone that has done more for the kingdom of God than Norman and Ruth Peale or have meant any more in my own life and the encouragement that they have given me. I am highly honored to be here to address you." Graham said: "My wife is a Presbyterian and her denomination is in the National Council of Churches."

..Dr. Peale And The Graham Crusade Results..The New York Times for Jan. 26, 1958 carried a large four-column article by George Dugan entitled: "Graham's Impact Held Fleeting As Ministers Appraise Crusade." This article tried to give a factual report of how the convert cards were distributed after Graham's 1957 Crusade in Madison Square Garden. "Marble Collegiate Church, whose pastor is the Rev. Dr. Norman Vincent Peale, received the largest number of referrals- 373. Of these, 184 were listed as new names. A comment from a church spokesman said that there was no way to determine how many of the new individuals still attended church."

..Jerry Falwell And Dr. Norman Peale..Dr. Jerry Falwell of Lynchburg joined with Dr. Norman Vincent Peale in performing a wedding ceremony on Sept. 2, 1978 in Orlando, Florida at the First Baptist Church of Windemere. The paper said: "Dr. Norman Vincent Peale and Dr. Jerry Falwell jointly officiated at the ceremonies." (Cont. next column).....

JESUS' PERSON STILL DIVIDES RELIGION

In John's Gospel, we read concerning Jesus (8:43)- "So there was a division among the people because of him." Rabbi Stephen Fuchs is the author of "Teaching Judaism to Lutheran Seminarians" in the liberal Christian Century for April 30, 1980. He wrote: "My professor of New Testament, the late Samuel Sandmel, used to say that we Reform rabbis would have more in common with liberal-minded Christian ministers than with Orthodox rabbis who would no doubt disparage our learning and despise our outlook. I never thought I would agree with him. To a degree, I still do not. Jesus remains the chasm that separates even the most open and accepting Jews. But the kinship I feel with my students in Philadelphia is far greater than the kinship I feel with those Orthodox rabbis in Baltimore who refuse to meet as a body with non-Orthodox rabbis, and who deny that any religious expression other than their own has the right to call itself Jewish. The difference, I guess is this: with Christians who affirm the validity and importance of Judaism, I feel accepted as a person and respected for my beliefs. With certain Orthodox Jews, I feel neither of these things."

..In The Same New York Graham Crusade.... The Times continued: "Riverside Church received 135 referrals, forty-seven of whom were already affiliated. Twenty-three moved away, thirty-four failed to respond to a follow-up sixteen joined the church and fifteen are likely prospects." Riverside is one of the most apostate churches in the nation. Their pastor was on the Graham platform. This was the church originally built by Rockefeller funds when Harry Emerson Fosdick was Pastor.

...Anita Bryant Destroyed Her Influence as a great moral crusader by filing for divorce from her husband of 20 years, according to an RNS dispatch (5-23-80), from Miami-"Anita Bryant, who crusaded against 'the disintegration of the American family' has filed for divorce in a dispute that involves her ministry with homosexuals... She resigned from Anita Bryant Ministries, which she started to work with homosexuals whose lifestyle she opposed, and also asked other board member to change its name." ...Jerry Falwell At New Evangelical Church The Toronto Star for both May 3 and May 10, 1980 carried huge ads listing Dr. Falwell as speaking at the People's Church, the largest New Evangelical Church in Canada, on May 15, 1980. He was also listed as speaking at the big banquet of Richmond College, the leading New Evangelical college in Toronto area. The President of Richmond College is Ken Copeland. Dr. Charles Seidenspinner is Dean, and John Wesley White of the Graham team is the Chancellor.

The official paper of the Sudan Interior Mission "Africa Now" for May-July 1980 had a clever article on "Maintaining Biblical Balance", but which should have been entitled "Maintaining An Unscriptural Neutralism." It demonstrates a complete lack of understanding of the Biblical doctrine of Separation. It was written by Dr. Ian M. Hay, general director: "The doctrinal basis of SIM is clear-cut. Our standing in regard to the Scriptures is strong and unalterable. The very nature of our Mission, however, demands that we follow the tradition of evangelical pluralism. This means that we are evangelical in the original and precise meaning of that word; and that we agree to work together with those whose positions on secondary issues may differ from our own." Dr. Robertson McQuilkin, President of Columbia Bible College, uses a favorite statement: "It is much easier to go to a consistent extreme than to stay at the center of Biblical tension." In the matter of unity and purity in church relationships, for example, which is one of the issues that has torn the evangelical world, it is much easier to devote one's energy to standing strongly for total separation on the one hand, or arguing strongly for unity on the other (both of which are truths), rather than seeking to find a balance, which is found in the Scriptures. We are committed to evangelical pluralism because that's where the Scriptures stand. The balance in Scripture is a very beautiful thing. Truths rarely stand alone. The late A.W. Tozer said: "Truths that are compelled to stand alone never stand straight and are not likely to stand long. Truth is one, but truths are many. Scriptural truths are interlocking and interdependent. A truth is rarely valid in isolation." (B.P.)- The Bible is very clear. It states: "And touch not the unclean thing"- II Cor. 6:17. That's total separation. When Moses left Egypt he told Pharaoh there must be total and complete separation: "Our cattle also shall go with us; there shall not an hoof be left behind; for thereof must we take to serve the Lord our God." Exodus 10:26.

Smith, Jacob Bellig (of Castro Valley's Crossroads Cathedral- Neighborhood Church) and other speakers. Dr. Bellig is the Chairman of the Executive Committee of this institution which Dr. London and Dr. W.S. McBurnie direct. The Executive Committee also includes Dr. Jerry Falwell.

Enterprise for the First Quarter 1980 has a picture of Dr. Tim LaHaye and Dr. Elmer Towns on the front page.

..Holland B. London at People's Church....The Toronto Star for June 7, 1980 (p. H8) carried a large ad by the People's Church of Toronto, showing that Dr. Holland B. London, president of California Graduate School of Theology was the speaker both morning and evening on June 8, 1980 and again on June 10. This church is the largest New Evangelical Church in Canada, and the California Graduate School of Theology is one of the leading New Evangelical schools in the USA. On June 15, 1980, Dr. Holland London appeared on the Jerry Falwell broadcast on TV released on Channel 4 in the Bay Area, after conferring honorary doctorates on two of Falwell associates.



SOUTHERN BAPTIST CONVENTION INFORMATION

..Southern Baptist President Speaks Out...
The new conservative President of the SBC, Rev. Bailey E. Smith of Del City, Oklahoma was quoted in the Greenville Piedmont, June 12, 1980, at a news conference in St. Louis (AP)- "I'm not out to axe anybody. I intend to serve every segment of the denomination. The liberals we have are few compared to the great majority of our people. I don't know of any great meticulous plan to weed out people one by one." (BP)- This is a sad confession of an Biblically inadmissible condition- inclusivism. The Bible says, "A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump." Leaven is always and everywhere evil in the Bible. The presence of unbelief in the SBC should be a signal for an immediate campaign to root out all liberalism. Remember a liberal in an infidel. For conservatives in the SBC to tolerate infidelity in the SBC is to be guilty of wilful disobedience against the very inerrant Word of God they profess to believe.

..These Words Are Not Quite Right or True
The RNS dispatch of June 18, 1980 from Dallas: "The book that has bound Southern Baptists together for 135 years is now the book that divides them..." "We have no need of a creed because we have the Bible and who can improve on that?" proclaimed Dr. Adrian Rogers in his presidential address to the Southern Baptist Convention's recent annual meeting in St. Louis. "Southern Baptists will continue as people of the book. We will believe it, claim it, love it, preach it and pour it forth as white-hot lava." (BP) No, this is not quite right, because all six major seminaries of the SBC do not teach that the Bible is the objective divine Word of the living God, but merely a record of that revelation, or a sign pointing to, or a channel of that revelation. Since the fountain head is poisoned, the seminaries, the future is theologically bleak and treacherous. One day the white-hot lava will explode and the whole top of the SBC mountain will blow up, revealing the pluralistic and inclusivistic corruption which is now boiling underneath.

THE SLIMY TRAIL OF RELIGIOUS COMPROMISE

..New Evangelicals Push Liberal Authors..
Pulpit Helps for May 1980, is a ministry of AMG, with Dr. Spiros Zodhiantes, President. On page 7 is a large ad by Westminster Press, advertising a number of abominable books. One is by L. Harold DeWolf, who was the liberal Boston University mentor of M.L. King, Jr. The other is a book by William Barclay, whom Harold Lindsell says was not even a Christian.

..The Unbelief of Dr. Harold DeWolf... Dr. DeWolf delivered the funeral tribute for Martin Luther King on April 9, 1968 in Atlanta. He is the liberal professor at Boston University School of Theology. In his book "The Case for Liberal Theology", he states: "The Bible itself is by no means infallible. In it are to be found erring words of men as well as the authoritative word of God..." p. 47. He casts doubt on the Virgin Birth of Christ. (61) does not believe in the Christian God, the Holy Trinity (104). He states that the Christian doctrine of the tri-personality in unity is un-Christian, unthinkable, and irrational mystery-mongering. (104 ff). He has this to say about the sacrifices of Christ: "certainly we ought to repudiate the notion that God is unwilling to forgive any sin until blood has been spilt as a propitiation... This is not a legal transaction required by God, in which God demands his pound of flesh and took it from Christ instead of us." (77). (These were all quotes from the Christian News for April 15, 1968).

..Dr. Falwell Speaks for New Evangelicals
The Association of Christian Schools International is the New Evangelical organization for "Christian" schools in America. The American Association of Christian Schools is the Fundamental group. Dr. Jerry Falwell is listed in the Administrator's Newsletter of the ACSI as speaking for the New Evangelicals in the following Conventions this Fall: Daytona Beach; Columbus, Ohio; Lynchburg, Virginia; Atlanta, Georgia; and Long Beach, Ca. If Jerry Falwell is a Fundamentalist, he is using his influence, energies, and time in the support of the New Evangelicals. There is no member of the Fundamental Baptist Fellowship who regards Falwell as a Fundamentalist.
