Wednesday, September 20, 1815.

- 1. At 10 o'clock, Brother Joseph Grafton, according to appointment, delivered the introductory discourse from 1 Cor. ii. 1, 2. After which there was a collection for the widows and children of deceased ministers.
- 2. Chose Brother THOMAS BALDWIN, Moderator, and Brother Elisha Williams, Clerk.
- 3. Appointed Brethren, BALDWIN, WILLIAMS, and GRAF-TON, a Committee, to count and make distribution of the money collected for the widows and children of deceased ministers.

The Messengers from sister Corresponding Associations were invited to take a seat with us.—After reading a few of the letters from the churches, adjourned until half past 2 o'clock.—Prayer by the Moderator.

- 4. Met pursuant to adjournment; after prayer, by Brother Gammell, proceeded to read the letters from the Churches, and took the following account of the members added, dismissed, excluded, or who have died the past year, and the present number in each church.
