MINUTES, &c.

WEDNESDAY, September 26.

1. AT ten o'clock, A.M. brother James Hooper delivered the introductory sermon, from 1 Tim. ii. 5. *For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.*

2. Chose brethren Sylvanus Boardman, Moderator, and brother Thomas Francis, Clerk.

3. After prayer by brother Blood, chose elders Low, Tripp, and deacon Norton a committee, to apportion the money for printing the Minutes, upon the churches.

4. Voted, That the messengers from sister Associations and baptized brethren from distant parts, be invited to take a seat with us.

5. Read the letters from the several churches, and took the following account of members added, dismissed, excluded, or who have died the year past; and the present number in each church.
