S A T U R D A Y, August 7, 1794.

1. **A**T twelve o'clock, Brother George Smith delivered the introductory Sermon from Rom. xii. 5. "So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another."

2. Letters from 24 Churches were read.

3. Brother **AMBROSE DUDLEY**, was chosen Moderator, and **JOHN PRICE**, Clerk.
