WEDNESDAY, MAY 21.

1. **ASSEMBLED** at 3 o'clock, P. M. for Public Worship, in the Baptist Meeting-House in Gold-Street. Brother William Parkinson preached the Introductory Sermon, from 2 Cor. 4, 5: "*We preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord, and ourselves your servants for Jesus sake.*"

2. Brother Runyan prayed. Brother Parkinson was chosen Moderator, and Brother Lahatt, Clerk.

3. Letters from the Churches were read.
