OF THE

Philadelphia Baptist Association,

HELD, BY SPECIAL APPOINTMENT,

At COHANSEY, New-Jersey, October 4th, 5th, and 6th, A. D. 1803.

TUESDAY, October 4th, 1803.

1. **A**T 3 o'clock, P. M. Brother JAMES M'LAUGHLIN, being prevented by affliction in his family from attending, Brother JAMES EWING preached the Introductory Sermon, from *Matthew xxiii. 8. One is your Master EVEN Christ; and all ye are Brethren.*

2. After Sermon, business was opened with Prayer by Brother ALLISON, when Brother SAMUEL JONES was chosen Moderator, and Brother WILLIAM STAUGHTON, Clerk.

3. Letters from twenty-nine Churches were read.

Adjourned till 9 o'clock, to-morrow morning.—Brother ROGERS concluded by Prayer.
