ist. The Messengers presented in terms from twenty-seven Churches, which were read in orders and choic Erother Robert Elkin, Moderator, and Productive Elkin, Moderator, and Moderator,

2d. The Aliociation then appointed a Committee of five Members (to wit:) Robt. Elkin, Thos. I. Chilton, Daniel Ramey, Samuel Johnson, and Moles Bledsoe, to arrange the business for the ensuing day; also the same Committee was vested with power to meet the Committee choice by the Elkhorn Association, to confer on terms of an union between the Baptists of the Eikhorn and South Kentucky Associations, and report to this Association.

3d. The Affociation then adjourned until next day at

8 o'clock.

4th. Met according to adjournment, and the Committee made their report which was agreed to by the Affociation.

5th. A motion was made for a divition of the Affociation and carried in the affirmative, and two districts were formed bounded as follows, viz. Beginning at the head of Paint Lick creek, and with the same to the mouth; thence down the Kentucky river to the mouth thereof, and Southwardly, to be called the South District; and Northwardly from said boundary, to be called the North District.

6th. The Church at Gilbert's creek, petitions for advice of the Affociation, respecting receiving certain members holding the doctrine of redemption from hell; for answer the Affociation refers them to the minutes of the Affociation of 1791, on that subject. 7th. In some letters addressed to the Association, there are petitions for an union between the Baptists of the Elkhorn and South Kentucky Associations, the Committee appointed to meet the Committee of Elkhorn Association met and conferred on the bunnels of an union, and made report of the term to the Association which was manimously agreed to; and that two members should be sens from each Church, to meet in Convention at Heward's creek Meeting-House, on the 2d Saturday in October, to carry said union into essect.

Sth. A petition comes from Chaplain's Fork of Salt river, for the constitution of a Charch, and ordination of a Minister. Brethren John Rice, and Bernard Noel are appointed to at-

tend to that bufine is.

9th. A petition from Greefy creek for the constitution of a Church. Brethren Joseph Bledtoe, Thos. Chilton, and John Rice are appointed to attend to that business.

16th. A petition for the constitution of a Church on Sugar creek. Brethren Samuel Whitney, Jesse Fears, and Charles

Finney are appointed to attend that bulinefs.

tith. A petition for the constitution of a Church on Goose creek of Green river. Brethren Joseph Bledsoe, Thos. Chilten, and John Rice are appointed to attend that business.

12th. A petition for the constitution of a Church on the head of Green river. Brethren Joseph Bledsoe, Thos. Chil-

ten, and John Rice are appointed to that buimels.

13th. A petition from the Church at the Mouth of Locust, for ordination. Brethren Joseph Rice, Moses Bledsee, and Leonard Turley, are appointed to that business.

14th. A petition from the Doctor's Fork of Chaplin, for the constitution of a Church. Brethren John Rice, and Ber-

nard Noel, are appointed to attend to that business.

15th. Some letters were addressed to the Association from the Islinois country, for advice respecting their government. Brethren Robt. Elkin, Moses Bledsoe, Thos. Chilton, Daniel Ramey, and Samuel Johnson were appointed to attend to that business.

16th. Some certificates were presented to the Association, respecting Brother Captain, a black man, who is a member of our society, and is preaching and baptizing and is not ordained; the Association advites him to join some Church most convenient, as also the members baptized by him.

17th. The Affociation appointed a Committee of Miniflers (towit:) John Rice, Bernard Noel, Joseph Bledfoe, and Thos. Collton, to examine into the qualifications of Brother I Lo Me Graw, as a preacher, and ordain him if they think proper.

day in September 1802.

19th. The Members of the North District, appointed their next Association at Unity Meeting-House on Four Mile, in Clark county, on the first Friday in October 1802. Read and approved. Signed by order.
