MINUTES, &c.

THE Elders and Brethren from the several Churches being met, Elder Asahel Morse from the Danbury Association, delivered the introductory Sermon, from *Rom. ii. 7.*

2. Chose Brother Samuel West, Moderator and Asa Spalding, Clerk.

6. As the Church at Killingly, have not attended with us, or represented themselves with us these three years, the Association appointed Brethren, Abel Palmer, Asher Miner and Jedediah Randal a Committee to visit said Church, & make Report to our next Association.

7. Adjourned till 9 o'clock to-morrow morning.

Brother Spalding to forward our Minutes to the Leyden Association. Brs. Goodall, Willcox, Whitman and Welch to the Otsego Association, and likewise to forward our Minutes to the Ransaleorville Association. Br. West to forward our Minutes to the Philadelphia Association.
