# MINUTES, &c.



WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 5, 1808.

1. **A**T 10 o'clock, A. M. Elder *Sylvanus Haynes* preached the introductory sermon from Psm. cii. 13, 14. "*Thou shalt arise and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favor her, yea the set time is come, For thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and favor the dust thereof.*"

2. A Moderator and Clerk were chosen.

3. Letters from the churches were read, and a list taken of their alterations, and present numbers.

**A. Missionary committee reported as follows.**

“Your committee charged with missionary affairs report, That Elder Isaac Sawyer has been employed on a mission on the west side of Lake Champlain, in the north part of the State of New-York, for the term of six weeks, for which he received 30 dols. He took his tour in Dec. and Jan. last. He travelled westward to Madrid, on the river St. Lawrence, more than 100 miles west of said lake, about 150 miles from his own home. He preached 38 sermons, baptised one person; and in company with Elder Finch, constituted a chh. at Maloué. He received from different societies for the missionary fund, 4,87 cents.

“Also, that Elder Samuel Rowley had been employed as a missionary seven weeks, for which he has received 35 dols. He took the above described tour, (about 200 miles from his own home) in the months of Aug. and Sept. During his mission, he preached 58 sermons; attended 10 conferences; baptised 17
