WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 4, 1809.

1. **A**T 10 o'clock, agreeably to appointment, Elder Henry Green delivered the introductory sermon from 1. Timothy, 6. 6. "*But Godliness with contentment is great gain.*"

2. A Moderator and Clerk were chosen.
