MINUTES, Oct. 6, 1819.

1. The Elders and Messengers, composing the association, convened at half past 10 o'clock, A. M. Introductory sermon, by Elder HENRY GREEN, from Job iii. 5.—*Is not thy wickedness great? and thine iniquities infinite?*

2. Made choice of Elder Clark Kendrick, Moderator, and Elder Joseph W. Sawyer, Clerk. Adjourned one hour.—Met according to adjournment. Prayer by Elder Heriston.

3. Messengers from Corresponding Associations were invited to a seat with us.

4. Proceeded to read the letters from the several churches composing the Association, and took the following account of their alterations the year past.
